Our goal is to provide excellent training in a loving and supportive environment.

We look for the “Amazing” in each student and create opportunities for them to use their giftings and acquired skills to glorify God.

The following information allows our Joyful Soles Families to work as a team toward this goal.

It’s a collection of answers and information that you need to know for our dancing season.

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## Communication

Email is our primary mode of communication. Via email, you will receive; your monthly tuition statement, event reminders, weather closures etc. Please be sure the email you use in Jackrabbit is current.

**Joyful Soles "Proclamation" Dance Company** = These are Dancers, age 14+, dancing in Level 2 or higher, taking a minimum 3 classes per week, who have submitted a Company application and presented a Company audition. Dancers accepted into "Proclamation" agree to Monday night rehearsals from 7-8:30 and pay an additional Company fee of \$200.

**Random "ACTS" Theatre** = Home Education Musical Theatre & Acting Students

**Random "ACTS" Vocal Music** = Home Education Vocal Music Students

## Registration

Registration is now available online or at the studio. Registration for our Fall/Spring season opens the mid-June. Summer registration opens March 16<sup>th</sup>. **Class selections** for our youngest dancers is based on age. Class selection for ages 9+ is based on dance training and proficiency, to be determined on Dance Placement Day or at an "in class" assessment.

## Placement Day

Placement Day is for dancers ages 9-Teen. On this day, a panel of instructors review our dancers. Within the next couple of weeks, each participant receives an email containing a list of recommended classes for our new season. This list allows dancers to enroll for our new season as soon as registration opens. Dancers younger than nine will be placed in classes based on age or Teacher recommendations. Older dancers who have not attended placement day will be assessed individually. If placement day was missed, please check with Miss Tami prior to registration for recommended levels and classes.

## Attendance

Dance is a “team sport” because each dancer is important to the overall success of the dance(s) they are in and the fluidity of the show. Please do your best to miss for illness only and schedule vacations during breaks. Students start learning techniques at the beginning of the school year to help build towards skills that will be choreographed and practiced as early as December for the Spring Production.

**Illness:** We technically do not have “make up” classes. A class missed is tuition lost. We do have a “Zoom” option. If your dancer cannot join us in person due to illness or weather, please call an hour before class to let us know they would like to join us via Zoom. We will create a meeting, send the link, and get our classroom equipment ready to receive you.

If your child will be **absent** from a class, please notify us as soon as possible through email at [joyfulsolesdance@live.com](mailto:joyfulsolesdance@live.com). In the subject line please include CHILD’S NAME – ABSENT TODAY and in the body of the email describe the reasons. Thank you. Knowing your dancer will be absent allows our teacher to adjust class plans and allows us to lift your dancer in prayer.

\*Multiple absences: Dancers, missing multiple classes for events scheduled after dance registration was completed, are welcome to continue to attend classes but may be asked to sit out of Christmas or the Spring Production. Each situation will be considered on an individual basis.

## Zoom

Please text **720-318-6220** by 7:30 AM if you need to zoom a *morning* class. For *afternoon* classes, please text by 3:00 PM. We will create a link for your class and send it to you. Then, we will boot up our classroom computer and watch for your dancer to join us. We understand that sometimes things like flat tires or other unplanned events take place and students hope to zoom at the last minute. We will do our best to get these students connected.

## Behavior Expectations

Dancers are expected to arrive ready to focus on dancing. Once Dancers step into their classroom their attention should be focused on their teacher. No talking with other dancers on the floor during instruction. Students who repeatedly interrupt the teacher or act silly to gain the attention of classmates will be asked to sit and watch or join our Ambassador to wait for parents. After class we will let you know that your dancer had a difficult time respecting their teacher and ask you to have a conversation with them. Thank you for helping us create a productive learning environment for all dancers.

## Cleanliness

Personal: Hand washing is the best way to prevent the spread of germs. Hands arriving from school, shopping, playground etc., bring a bit of the day’s activities with them. To keep from spreading any “unfriendlies”, we ask students and families coming into the studio to take a moment to cleanse hands using the hand sanitizer or baby wipes provided at the base of the stairs or head straight to the bathroom or kitchen to wash hands. THEN, after sharing equipment and/or holding hands in class... please cleanse hands again. Thank you.

Facility: Volunteer parents clean and touch up our studio throughout the week but they need help. If your dancer creates a mess, please use supplies available in the kitchen or under the bathroom sinks to clean up. Thank you for leaving our studio clean for the next dancers arriving.

## Cubbies

Please place all personal items in the cubbies provided in our waiting areas for studio 2 and 3. We need the furniture free of dancegear so dancers can sit and dance bags etc. off the floor so dancers can walk and stretch. Thank you.

## Arrival to Departure

Arrival: Please have dancers arrive 10-15 minutes before class begins in dress code attire, hair secured according to class requirements, and with a water bottle. If you have multiple items, please store in a dance bag. Please begin stretching.

ALL DANCERS – Please stay in the designated waiting area for your class until invited by your instructor to enter the classroom or take the floor.

MUSTARD SEEDS – please arrive early enough to use the restroom and get into shoes before class begins.

MUSTARDS 1 – Parents, please stay. We may need your assistance for emergency restroom visits.

MUSTARDS 2 & 3 – Parents, please assist your children as needed. You are welcome wait or run errands.

Special MUSTARD SEEDS instructions: Parents, please help prepare your dancer for class. Mustard Seeds should have a water bottle in hand and their TAP shoes on. Please have only BALLET shoes in their dance bag. No toys or snacks. Street clothes, toys, or snacks can be left in a waiting area in a cubby or with a parent. Thank you.

If you arrive after class has started: Please QUIETLY enter class and join in as quickly as possible. Apologies can be made during a break. MUSTARDS: Parents, please bring your dancer to their classroom door, say your farewells, open the door, and send them in. Please do not enter with them. Other little dancers quickly lose focus when a “mommy” enters. Those who had difficulty separating may suddenly need their mommy... resulting in lost class time as we get everyone settled again. Thank you for understanding.

Waiting?: Mustard Seeds parents are welcome to use our waiting areas. Parents of dancers ages 7+, please drop and go.

\*Special consideration is given to parents of dancers 9+ who travel a long distance to join us. We have comfy black chairs at the bottom of the stairs for you to wait in.

**Dancers** are welcome to stay at the studio and wait between classes. If you bring a snack or meal, please clean up after yourself including crumbs on the floor. Bring something quiet to do. Dancers are expected to stay in their designated waiting area quietly awaiting their next class. **Siblings are NOT allowed to play in hallways or studio spaces.** Parents must oversee siblings’ activities at all times. **For the safety of all, absolutely no tumbling, cartwheels etc. in the waiting areas.** *Please respect studio property. Only bottoms on our couches and no sitting or standing on their arms. Absolutely no playing on the stairs, running/playing tag in the studio. No sitting or standing on cubbies. Remember Joyful Soles is a Dance Studio, not a playground.* Thank you.

**Students and sibling who cannot abide by these requests will be asked to wait outside the studio.**

**Departure:** Mustard Seeds Families please meet your dancers in their waiting area. Parents of Students 7-9 Please TEXT Your Dancer’s Name to 303-596-6271 to let us know you are waiting outside or... quietly wait at the bottom of the stairs for them to appear. Please allow 5-10 minutes after class ends for us to bring your dancer to the front door. We will be putting street shoes and coats on then moving as a class to the bottom of the stairs to check for TEXTS. Thank you. If you are outside, please be sure we can see you from the front door so we can send your dancer safely to you. Tweens & Teens may simply exit on their own when they know you have arrived for pick-up.

## Quiet Please

Our space is small, and our walls are thin. Teachers and students can hear conversations in the hallways, on the stairs and in the kitchen. Please give each class the opportunity to learn without distraction.

## Drinks Policy

Please, teachers, dancers and family members, **WATER ONLY!** Water bottles should have a spill resistant top. (no open tops). Sticky and sugary drinks invite ants into our studio and stain our carpet. All dancers are welcome to refill water bottles in the kitchen.

## Food Policy

Please only bring non-crumbly snacks. Let’s not feed the ants! We have resident sugar ants in the alley behind the studio. They delight in the tiniest crumb and appear from seemingly nowhere when food is present. Meat sticks, protein bars, and pre-cut fruit are great snacks for dancers. If your dancer has more than two classes and needs to bring a meal, please remind them to clean up their space in the kitchen and eating area when they are done. Paper towels and a handheld vacuum are available in the kitchen.

## No Nuts Policy

We currently have a no nut policy, including peanuts, since we have dancers with nut and/or peanut allergies. Please be respectful of these dancers and do not send any snacks containing nuts or peanuts to the dance studio. Also, if these are eaten prior to arrival at the studio, please have your dancer wash their hands. Thank you for your help keeping our dancers safe.

## WiFi

The studio is equipped with WiFi so we can run music and ZOOM in 3 studios at once. We pay for the minimum plan needed to meet our requirements. We've been disconnected from Zoom on several occasions. Our Comcast representative came to assess our problem. He said we are paying for a Dirt Road plan, which is sufficient for our studio needs but insufficient for our studio family Superhighway needs. We simply have too many people using our "Road", so our Zoom connection is weakened and dropping. The next plan costs considerably more and isn't needed for actual classes. Going forward, if an Adult needs to use WiFi to do work on a device during classes, we'd like to accommodate you. We can no longer offer Wifi for phone connections or to students for entertainment. There are simply too many devices on The Road we need to run classes. Thank you for understanding.

## Studio Breaks

Our studio calendar lists all breaks and production dates. Our dancers represent four different school districts with varying break schedules. Our studio is in Jefferson County. We have used their school calendar to create ours.

Please note: We DO NOT close classes for ALL holidays so please check our studio calendar for specific dates. Thank you.

## Weather Policy

Our studio typically experiences the same weather conditions as the Littleton area. We take our lead on closing from the Littleton School District and/or government offices. If they close early, or don't open at all, we do the same.

CDOT – If CDOT issues a request asking Littleton residents to stay off the roads... we close.

Please put your family's safety first. If you judge the journey to be unwise, please TEXT your dancer(s) name and "staying home" to 720-318-6220. We greatly appreciate knowing in advance who to expect in class and who will be joining us on Zoom.

**HOW WILL YOU KNOW IF WE ARE CLOSING?** In addition to the Littleton School District, government offices, or CDOT closure notifications, we will send an email. The subject line will say "NO DANCE TODAY". If this is the case, Zoom will not be an option.

## Lost and Found

Please check to make sure you have all items before you leave. We have a lost and found box "Couch Room" If you realize something is missing, please call me. If I have it, I'll put your dancers name on it and they can pick it up when they come for class . Once a month, unclaimed items will be donated to Goodwill.

## Trading Boxes

There are "trading boxes" available if your shoes are getting too small and you would like to exchange them. We also gladly accept donations. If you need to trade, please notify us ahead of time that you will need assistance. Please arrive early so you can be fitted before class begins. Dancers must have the help of a teacher or volunteer. *The Trading Boxes are not meant for dancers who forgot their dance bags.*

## Dance Gear Swap

Swaps will be announced periodically. We will receive donations of CLEAN leotards, dance shoes of any kind, and other dancewear. Items will be organized on racks and a "Store/Swap" will be set-up for 2 weeks.

## Dance Gear Orders

In March, as we prepare for our May production, we will offer the purchase of Weissman products at our cost. We primarily order nude leotards, pink tights, and dance shoes of all styles. Families are welcome to purchase regular dancewear as well. You will receive an email containing an order form and sizing chart. Forms will also be available at the studio. Measure your dancer, select the items you need and bring your completed form along with payment (cash or check) to the studio. Please place your order in our tuition box. Orders cannot be accepted via email. Your completed form and payment are required to place your order. If you need help determining sizes, please send an email to [joyfulsolesdance@live.com](mailto:joyfulsolesdance@live.com) and we can arrange to meet with you and your dancer to determine fit. An email will be sent when orders arrive.

## Fundraising

This season we are offering two fundraising opportunities. Your sales proceeds will go directly to your account for "Production Fees." Any excess will go into our production budget. Our options are items we believe you or your loved ones will enjoy. This season we are using "Flower Power". They offer a beautiful selection of bulbs, flowers, and seeds. Orders are completed and paid for online then shipped at the appropriate time for planting directly to the purchaser for a flat shipping fee of \$7. This means you can share our link with family and friends far and near. We will once again sell "Butter Braids". Each family creates a "link" from "myfundraisingplace.com" to share with family and friends. This link will direct people to your "store" where they select and pay for their treats. On our set delivery dates, all orders placed through your store arrive at Joyful Soles. You pick up these frozen goodies, labeled with the purchaser's names and deliver to the people who ordered.

Specific information for placing orders of these products will arrive in separate emails at the appropriate times.

## **Christmas “Showcases”**

Instead of adding another event to your busy December calendar, we invite you to join us for the last 15 min. of your dancers’ class(es) December 16th – 20th for a mini showcase. You are welcome to record their presentation.

## **Homeschool “Random Acts” Musical Theater & Acting**

Our "elective" Home School Musical Theatre course includes Drama Instruction, Voice Training and Dance. We produce two plays each season. For more information, please look under the Homeschool Theater section on our website. [www.joyfulsolesdance.com](http://www.joyfulsolesdance.com)

**Auditions for Theatre take place the second week of each session.** This is how it works. Students fill out an audition form at home and bring it to their audition. They hand their form to our director along with a copy of their 1 min monologue and a device with their 1-1.5 min of music. (The Acting only class just needs the monologue.) Our Thespians take turns standing and auditioning for classmates. Auditions aid in casting our production and are great training for Thespians. Once characters have been assigned, Thespians begin memorizing lines. We suggest writing each of your lines on separate 3” x 5” cards. Number them so you know the order. Then, on the back of each card, write the line that comes just before yours. To practice, read the other character’s line and say your line. Flip the card over to see if you are right. **There are no auditions for Vocal Music.**

Students attend weekly classes and present their finished pieces at the beginning of our Theatrical presentations.

## **Dance Intensives and Dance Camps**

Each year, there are Summer Dance Camps available for each age group under 13 and Dance Intensives available for dancers Level 1 and up (dancers ages 14+ with at least one year of dance experience). Feel free to invite friends from outside of Joyful Soles as well! The more the merrier! The Dance Intensives have Professional Christian dancers from the metro area as Guest Teachers for the day. This is a wonderful way to challenge our dancers and open their eyes to the endless possibilities!

## **Outreaches**

We love the opportunity to share the joy Jesus puts in our hearts with others through dance. With parental permission and assistance with transportation, we may take dancers to churches, missions fundraising events, and retirement communities. If your church or organization is interested in having a group of dancers come. Please contact Miss Tami: 720-318-6220. We need a minimum floor space measuring 28’ x 15’ that is free of cords and obstacles.

## **Spring Production**

Our Spring Production is much more than a “recital.” It is an opportunity for our dancers to experience playing/dancing a part of a big story. A story that always points our audience to Jesus. A detailed handout of information on the Spring Production for will be available later in the year. TICKETS? Why... The average cost of costuming, transporting, renting a venue, and more, is \$18,000. Per production. Our production fee helps with these costs but does not cover the full amount. Our ticket sales make up the difference. Your production fee includes two tickets to our Spring Presentation. All Mustard Seeds families receive an additional ticket for their little dancer. This allows the Mustard Seed to sit with family after their dance is finished to watch the remainder of our story. Dancers ages 7+ do not sit with families. They have class seating in our auditorium.

## **Production Fees**

“Random ACTs” Vocal Music Class - Annual Production Fee: \$45 per student.

“Random ACTs” Acting Class Annual Theatre Production Fee: \$90 = 1st family member; \$45 = each additional family member.

“Random ACTs” Musical Theater Annual Production Fees: \$90 = 1st family member; \$45 = each additional family member.

Joyful Soles Dancers-Spring Production Fee: \$125 for Mustard Seeds and \$175 for ages 7+. We offer a family discount of \$25 for each additional dancer.

## **Picture Days**

The week of April 21<sup>st</sup> - 25<sup>th</sup> we will be taking “In Class” Pictures. Please send your dancer to class with hair “picture ready.” There will not be retakes. If a dancer misses class... they miss the opportunity to have a picture with their friends.

## **Volunteers**
